

Zoom Update: May 30, 2020

Beginning May 30, ASU faculty, staff and students will be required to run Zoom version 5.0 or later to join meetings. Additionally, if you don't have this version downloaded, you will be prompted to do so at that time. This new update includes improved secure encryption and an easier way to report an attendee who is misusing the platform, as well as enhanced options for when the hosts need to leave early.

We recommend attempting to update your Zoom before Saturday, May 30.

Updating on Windows

In Windows, start the Zoom client by clicking the Windows button in the bottom left hand corner of the screen and scrolling down to find Zoom. Click to start Zoom. In the upper right hand corner where your initials or profile picture are, click to expand the menu. Click on "Check for Updates".
